Daniel 7:5 And behold another beast, a second, *like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, ...*

Daniel 8:3 ... behold, there stood before the river a ram which had *two horns: and the two horns were high; but one was higher than the other, and the higher came up last.*

Daniel 8:20 The ram which thou sawest having *two horns are the kings of Media and Persia.*

Daniel 7:6 After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it *four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.*

Daniel 8:21 ... *goat is the king of Grecia: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king.*

Daniel 8:22 Now that being broken, whereas *four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation ...*

331 BC – 168 BC



Daniel 7:7 ... and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, *and stamped the residue* with the feet of it: and it was *diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.*

Daniel 7:8 I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another *little horn*, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn *were eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.*

Daniel 8:9 And out of one of them came forth *a little horn*, which waxed exceeding great, toward the south, and toward the east, and toward the pleasant *land.*
