




King of the North Seleucus I Nicator 312-280 BC

Note

Dan 11:5 And the King of the South (Ptolemy I Soter 323-285 BC) shall be strong, and *one of his (Alexander's) princes (Lysimachus takes over Cassander's portion of Alexander's kingdom and in turn it is taken over by Seleucus I Nicator 312-280 BC the King of the North)* ; and he shall be strong above him (*about three quarters of Alexander's previous kingdom goes to the King of the North*), and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion.

Alexander's Kingdom eventually divides into the two larger sections of the Seleucid Empire to the North and the Ptolemaic Empire to the South in Egypt
