Dan 11:23 And after **the league made with him** he shall work **deceitfully**: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people.
after the league made with him Rome made a league with the Jews in 161 BC.
he shall work deceitfully
Rome worked deceitfully because they never kept this league. They conquered the Jews in 63 B.C.

Dan 11:24 He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do *that which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: yea, and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, **even for a time (i.e. 31 BC-330 AD)**.*

Dan 11:29 At the time appointed he shall return, and come toward the south; **but it shall not be as the former**, or as the latter.
At the time appointed - The time appointed, or the end of the 360 years which ended in 330 A.D.
He shall return - Constantine shall return.
Come toward the south - Constantine came toward Licinius.
But it shall not be as the former, or as the latter - This war was not to be as the former wars against Egypt nor as the latter against Judea and Jerusalem. It was an in house war between Constantine in the west and Licinius in the east, as the Roman empire was divided into east and west at that time. Rome's Capital moved East from Rome to Constantinople.
