Babylonian Cuneiform Tablets reveal 457 BC as the 7th year of Artaxerxes

- 457 BC the 7th year of Artaxerxes is securely established in the astronomer "Ptolemy's Canon" with more than 20 Eclipses recorded some during Artaxerxes' reign
 457 BC the 7th year of Artaxerxes is recorded in "Babylonian Cuneiform Tablets" used
- 2. 457 BC the 7th year of Artaxerxes is recorded in "Babylonian Cuneiform Tablets" used to record business transactions.
- 3. 457 BC the 7th year of Artaxerxes is also written in the double dated Egyptian and Persian-Babylonian calendars written by Jews in the "Elephantine Papyri" from Egypt 4. 457 BC the 7th year of Artaxerxes found in "Olympiad dates" recorded by Herodotus and other Greek Historians preserved with their own dating system of the Olympiads
