

Dan 11:7 But out of a branch of her roots shall one stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail:

Dan 11:8 And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, and with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue more years than the king of the north.

Dan 11:9 So the king of the south shall come into his kingdom, and shall return into his own land.

Ptolemy III Euergetes 246-221 BC the brother of Berenice when he came to rule after the death of his father entered into the kingdom of Seleucus II Callinicus 246-226 BC to avenge the murder of his sister and the violation of the agreement of peace between the North and the South by both Laodice the mother of Seleucus II and himself. Ptolemy III took over much of the Seleucid territory and would have taken more if he wasn't called back because of trouble in his home territory of Egypt . Ptolemy III took home a large portion of riches from his conquest in the North. As prophesied Ptolemy III continued five years longer than his enemy in the North.
