Persecution

Diocletian 284-305 AD and Galerius 305-311 AD brought the largest and most brutal official persecution of Rome on the Christians 303 -313 AD

The ships of Chittim - literally of the Mediterranean - triumphant over Rome

Roman Papal State begins 1260 years of unbroken rule over Europe

Constantine Roman Emperor of the West defeats Licinius the Roman Emperor of the East who was the last defender of Paganism and persecutor of Christians in the battle of Chrysopolus 324 AD

Genseric also spelled Gaiseric the Vandal king rules the Mediterranean from 439-474 AD attacking Western and Eastern Rome

Papal Rome forsakes the holy covenant, pollutes the sanctuary and takes away the daily by the earthly priesthood, mass and confessional
